They are all components of the Springville Field and Stream's "Springville Community Trout Pond Renovation Project."

The Springville Field and Stream Club has engaged the services and resources of Local, County, State and Federal agencies as well as private corporations, individuals and organizations to develop a three phase plan to:

- Eliminate invasive plants
- Improve water quality
- Dredge and renovate the pond
- Improve and create public wheelchair accessible fishing
- Restore and improve the fish habitat
- Rebuild the former on-site fish hatchery
- Add a new learning center for aqua-culture

This project will not only serve the recreational needs of the Springville community but it will also be available as a regional destination for environmental learning and assisting regional fisheries within the Cattaraugus and Eighteen Mile Creek watersheds.

WHO WE ARE

The Springville Field and Stream Club, Inc. and Green Springville, Inc. are two local organizations who promote sustainable conservation and recreation values within the community and the region surrounding the Town of Concord.

- Increase local Trout populations


PROJECT LOCATION
